I just wanted to give you a head's up that all members will be receiving a ballot in the mail for a local-wide election. Local 101 is entitled to 8 delegates to the AFSCME Council 57 board. Currently, all winners are elected with the highest votes received. There are no rules or guidelines in place for a fair *percentage representation* of chapters. In other words, the biggest chapter usually wins all the marbles. The largest chapter in Local 101 has over 3,000 people—we are the second largest and the rest are smaller still, right down to 12 members in the San Lorenzo Water District. The EA officers are hopeful that this election, which as a dozen or so candidates running and some from several smaller chapters, will provide a chance for them to participate at that level of union government. Our very own **Jan Ortiz** is the Election Chair, many thanks to her for her hard work.
